

Downloading books from OverDrive for use on a Kindle

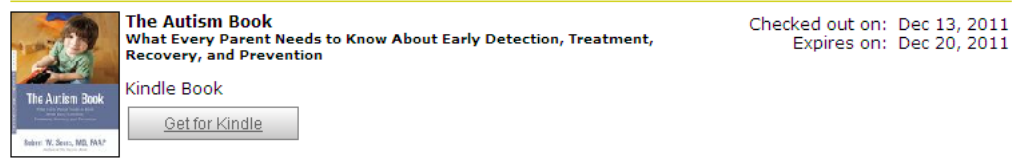
- Go to www.pdslibrary.org and click the OverDrive button on the lower left side.
- Begin browsing for eBooks. Use the search box or browse the categories given on the left.
- Titles available for checkout on Kindles will have the following image. Not all eBooks in OverDrive are available on Kindles. If a title is currently available you will see the link **Add to My Cart**. If there are no copies currently available you will see the link **Place a Hold**.



Checking Out:

- Once you find a title you would like to check out, click “add to my cart.” You may then continue browsing (you may have up to 10 items checked out).
- When you are ready to checkout, you need to identify your library system (South Central), enter your complete library card number and confirm checkout. *If you want to extend the checkout period beyond 7 days, you may do so before clicking the confirm check out button.**
- After materials are checked out, click the Get for Kindle button. You will then see a message that you are going to be taken away from the library’s download platform. Click accept to continue.

Kindle Users: By selecting 'Get for Kindle' you will be leaving the library's download platform to a third party service. This third party service may not have the same policies as the library does regarding privacy or management of your user information.



Transferring to Kindle:

- An Amazon window will open. If you are not already logged in to your Amazon account, you will be prompted to do so.
- After logging in, click the Get library book button. Your kindle should appear after Deliver to:



- If you have access to an active Wi-Fi connection, you can sync your kindle to download the book wirelessly. After clicking Get library book, click the menu button on your Kindle and select the sync option.
- If you do not have access to a Wi-Fi connection, you must transfer the books via the USB cable that came with the Kindle. See next page for more detailed instructions.
- Materials are automatically returned on the due date. You may return titles early if desired by going to your Manage My Kindle page and choosing Return this book under the actions button.
- Even though titles expire, they will stay in your Kindle library until you remove them.

*You may set default lending periods for your account. Click **my account** in the top right corner and choose **lending periods**.

- If you do not have access to a Wi-Fi connection, you must transfer the books via the USB cable that came with the Kindle.
 - Go to your Manage My Kindle page and click the actions button next to the title you want to transfer.
 - Choose Download and transfer via USB. You may be prompted to open or save the file; choose Save and select a location that is easy to find again, such as the desktop.

- Once the file has been saved, connect your Kindle device to your computer using a USB cable.
- Your Kindle device will appear in the same location as external USB drives usually appear. For Windows users, this is typically in the My Computer menu. For Mac users, the drive will appear on the desktop.
- Open the Kindle drive. You will see several folders inside, one of which will be named "documents." This is the folder you will move the downloaded file into.
- Locate the downloaded file and copy it into the documents folder. You can generally copy files by clicking and dragging the file to the folder.
- Safely eject your Kindle device from your computer and unplug the USB cable. Your content will appear on the Home screen.
