

Downloading books from OverDrive for use on Nooks

Please note: you can no longer download books from OverDrive on library computers.

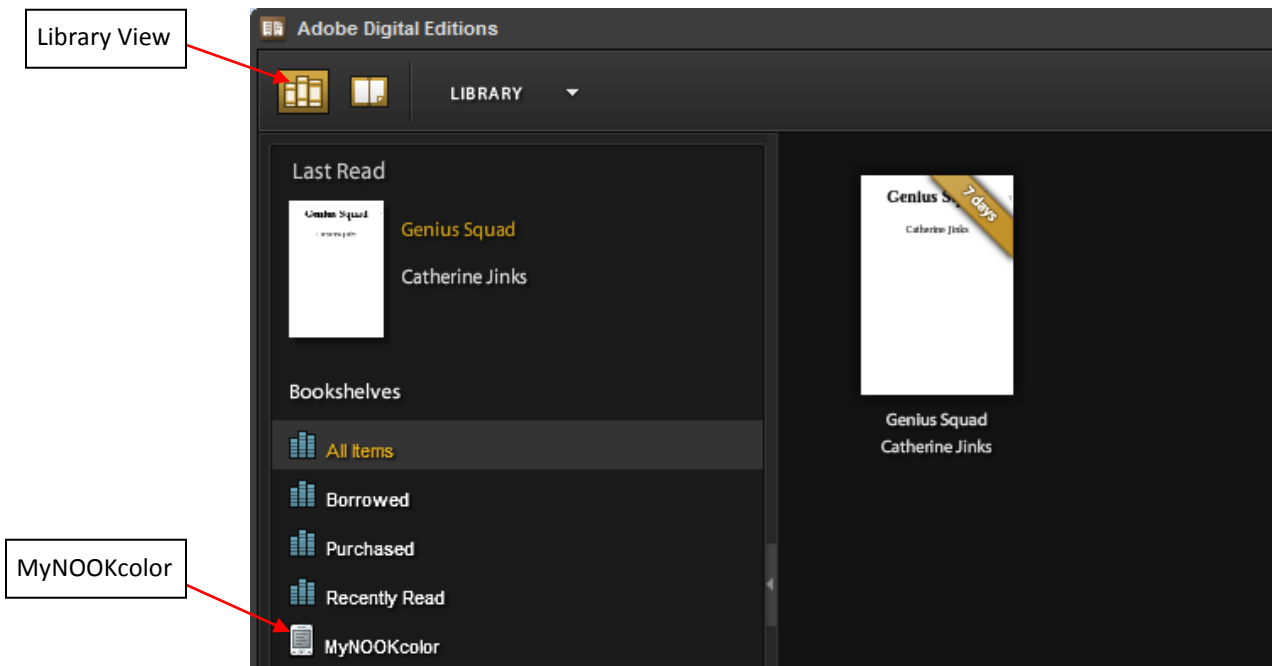
- Go to www.pdslibrary.org and click the OverDrive button on the lower left side.
- Begin browsing for eBooks. Use the search box or browse the categories given on the left.
- As a first time user be sure to download Adobe Digital Editions. A link to download can be found at the bottom left side of the page under the title *Getting Started*. A link for the necessary software will also be provided after you check out.

Checking Out:

- Once you find a title you would like to check out, click “add to my cart.” You may then continue browsing (you may have up to 10 items checked out).
- When you are ready to checkout, you need to identify your library system (South Central), enter your complete library card number and confirm checkout. *If you want to extend the checkout period beyond 7 days, you may do so before clicking the confirm checkout button.**
- After materials are checked out, you must choose to download (the button next to the image of the book).
- To view books, open Adobe Editions on your computer.
- Materials are automatically returned on the due date. The files will remain on your computer but will no longer be accessible and need to be manually deleted. You may return eBook titles early if desired.

Transferring to Nook:

- Open Adobe Digital Editions on your computer.
- Using the USB cord provided, connect the Nook to your computer.
- Make sure you are on “Library View” and can see MyNOOKcolor under bookshelves.
- Make sure you have “All Items” highlighted to see titles available for transfer.
- To add a title to the Nook, drag it from the box on the right to MyNOOKcolor. (To drag left click and hold down on the title. Move the mouse where you want the title to go.)



- When you are done transferring titles, close Adobe Editions and safely eject the Nook using the Eject Media icon near the computer clock.
- You can now remove the Nook from your computer.
- The transferred title can be found in the Nook library in the Digital Editions folder under My Files.



*You may set default lending periods for your account. Click **my account** in the top right corner and choose **lending periods**.
