

**Village of Prairie du Sac
Recycling Requirements
Effective January 1, 2002**

To meet state recycling requirements, the Village of Prairie du Sac enacted a recycling ordinance which became effective on January 1, 1995, which made it mandatory to recycle certain items, add fines for noncompliance, identify new responsibilities for owners/managers of multi-family buildings and non-residential buildings, and for developers/builders. Copies of the recycling ordinance may be obtained (at cost) at the Village Hall. **Tim's Trucking will pick up recycling material on Tuesdays.**

Computer Monitors cost \$10.00 for removal.

Mandatory Recycling (these items may be placed in a clear plastic bag together)

Aluminum

Steel containers

Glass

Bi-metal containers

Plastics labeled #1 - #7

Corrugated Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard must be bundled separately, broken down flat, tied securely both ways, no greater than 10 inches high or 40 lbs. and 3x3 bundle.

Newspapers

Newspapers must be bundled separately, tied securely both ways, no greater than 10 inches high or 40 lbs.

Magazines

Magazines must be bundled separately, tied securely both ways, no greater than 10 inches high or 40 lbs.

Foam Polystyrene

Foam polystyrene should be bagged separately.

Office Paper

Office paper should be bagged separately.

Yard Waste

Yard waste may not be deposited in the landfills. The Village will continue to collect yard waste separately from trash and use in the Compost Centers compost-mulch pile. Residents are urged to re-use leaves and grass clippings as mulch in the yard.

Multifamily Dwellings

Owners/managers of multi-family dwellings (5 units or more) must provide separate containers for the regular collection of recycled materials outside, and wherever practicable, and within the building(s). Additionally, the owner/manager must notify new tenants of the recycling requirements and all tenants annually.

Commercial, Retail, Industrial, Institutional Facilities and Properties

Owners/managers of non-residential facilities must provide adequate, separate containers for recyclable materials. Owners/managers must also notify, at least semi-annually, all users, lessees and occupants of these properties about the recycling requirements.

Developers and Builders

Developers or builders of residential buildings with 5 units or more, or an office or commercial building in the Village must make space considerations for recycling containers within the building, in each apartment, on every floor, or in a central area within the building. Additionally, a separate structure for recyclable material must be established on the grounds accessible to collection vehicles. This requirement shall be part of the inspection requirements of the Building Inspector for new construction.

Refuse Schedule
Effective January 1, 2000**

SUMMER (March through October)

- Monday: Brush. Limbs for chipping are limited to 4" in diameter. Contractors are responsible for removing their trimmings.
- Tuesday: Burnables. Including clean wood (no nails, metals, tar paper or tar shingles attached) pallets, garden and yard waste, weeds, twigs.
- Wednesday: Burnables. Including clean wood (no nails, metals, tar paper or tar shingles attached) pallets, garden and yard waste, weeds, twigs.
- Thursday: Grass clippings, leaves (must be bagged, no sticks in bags, labeled, not exceeding 50 lbs.) cement.
- Friday: Grass clippings, leaves (must be bagged, no sticks in bags, labeled, not exceeding 50 lbs.) cement.

NOTE: If a holiday falls on Monday, brush will not be picked up that week. Rain may affect the schedule. Refuse should be put out the night before the scheduled day. Loose leaves and grass clippings will be picked up from approximately April 1 through May 31 (depending upon the weather) using the Leaf Vacuum. Place leaves in the tree bank, curb or gutter.



Any appliance with Freon, must have the Freon removed before pickup. For the pick up of appliances, large accumulations of rubbish, vehicle tires and construction or building materials, call Tim's Trucking, LLC at 643-8760.

Tim's Truck, LLC will collect the following: metal on Friday, recycling material on Tuesday, rubbish/garbage (check scheduled day at the Village Hall).

Newspaper and cardboard must be tied securely.

Should a Holiday fall on the regular scheduled day of your garbage pickup day, collection will be the previous day.
