

## Library Cards



Library cards are available free of charge and can be

used at any library in the South Central Library System. Apply in person by bringing a photo ID and proof of your current address. Children under age 14 will need a parent or guardian present.

If your card is lost or stolen, please contact the library immediately as you are responsible for any materials checked out on your card. Replacement cards are \$1.00.

## Online Library Catalog

Download the LINKcat app on your mobile device, or go to [www.linkcat.info](http://www.linkcat.info), where you can search for and request materials, renew items you need longer, and manage your account.

## Computers & Equipment
