

# SPECIAL NIGHT MARKET EVENT: MUSICIAN DAVID LANDAU



## **JUNE'S BOOK REVIEW**

#### Shrines of Gaiety by Kate Atkinson

The year is 1926, the setting London. The city is still recovering from World War I and the flu epidemic. Nightclub owner Nellie Coker has just been released from six months in jail. Nellie owns half a dozen clubs where flappers and playboys go to drink and do drugs. Nellie has six children, some of whom run her businesses.

In another part of London Detective Chief Inspector John Frobisher has been moved from another precinct to Soho. Young girls are going missing and being found drowned in the Thames.

Two other characters, Florence and Frieda, have run away from home hoping to become dancers. Frobisher enlists a young librarian, Gwendolyn, to infiltrate Nellie's night club hoping to jail her for good.

Author Atkinson weaves the stories together in the end. The diverse cast of characters and period detail are very entertaining.
