#### NEW! Drop-In Fridays!


Fridays, August 18 & 25, 2:00pm We'll have a variety of supplies for DIY projects, tabletop games and snacks! Drop-in and do what you want!

#### Good Night, Irene by Luis Alberto Urrea

Many baby boomers like myself grew up with their parents' memories of World War II. My father was in the Merchant Marines on a supply ship in New Guinea. My uncles were in the Army and

the Navy. The author's mother served in the Red Cross in a group called the Clubmobile Corp. All female volunteers provided coffee, donuts and conversation to the troops.

The two main characters of this story are Irene, from a well-to-do family in New York City, and Dorothy, from Indiana. They are the crew of a two and a half ton truck that Dorothy drives.

The writing makes you feel like you're there in Europe with Dorothy and Irene risking their lives near the front lines. There are battle scenes, acts of bravery and sometimes barbarity.

# POKÉMON CLUB






## **DROP-IN MINDFULNESS**
