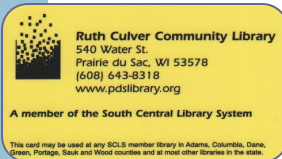

Online Library Catalog

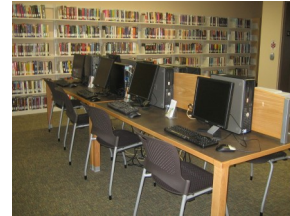
