Library Open by Appointment

The Ruth Culver Community Library is currently open for browsing the collection, computer use and other basic services by appointment. Appointments are on the hour and can be made by calling 608-643-8318. In most cases, you will be able to come the same day and even name the hour you'd like to come. Evening appointments are especially easy to get. Please maintain social distancing and remember **masks are required** to enter the building, even if you are only briefly in the lobby.

Computer Use

Two computers are available in the library for 45-minute appointments made on the hour. You may also schedule an appointment to enter the library for printing and copying. If you wish to bring in your own laptop, our express station will continue to be available as well with a 45-minute limit.
